2. Training Programme on Better Spoken English

Madhumathi and Ms G. LathaSuhasini of Freshman Engineering Department. Students of the neighboring villages attended Spoken English Classes for a week from 17th June to 22nd June. They were a heterogeneous group varying in levels of academic education and age group. They were from areas like Cheeryal, Yadgirpally, Bibi Nagar, Bhongir, ECIL. Kushaiguda etc. It is a known fact that Language cannot be imparted in a week but the faculty made a beginning to impart the basics of the language. The classes began on 17 June, 2019 at 9.30 am with 16 students in attendance. The session for the day began after formal pleasantries and an Ice-breaker. Grammar Classes on most important and basic topics like Parts of Speech, Articles and Tenses were covered on a remedial basis during five sessions. This improved their confidence to present their ideas better/ effectively in English. The classes to improve the Reading and Writing Skills were taken up effectively; these helped the students understand the nuances of the skills. The session on Letter Writing proved to be very helpful to the participants. The participants took active part in Speaking Activities like JAM, Situational Dialogues and Listening Comprehension.


