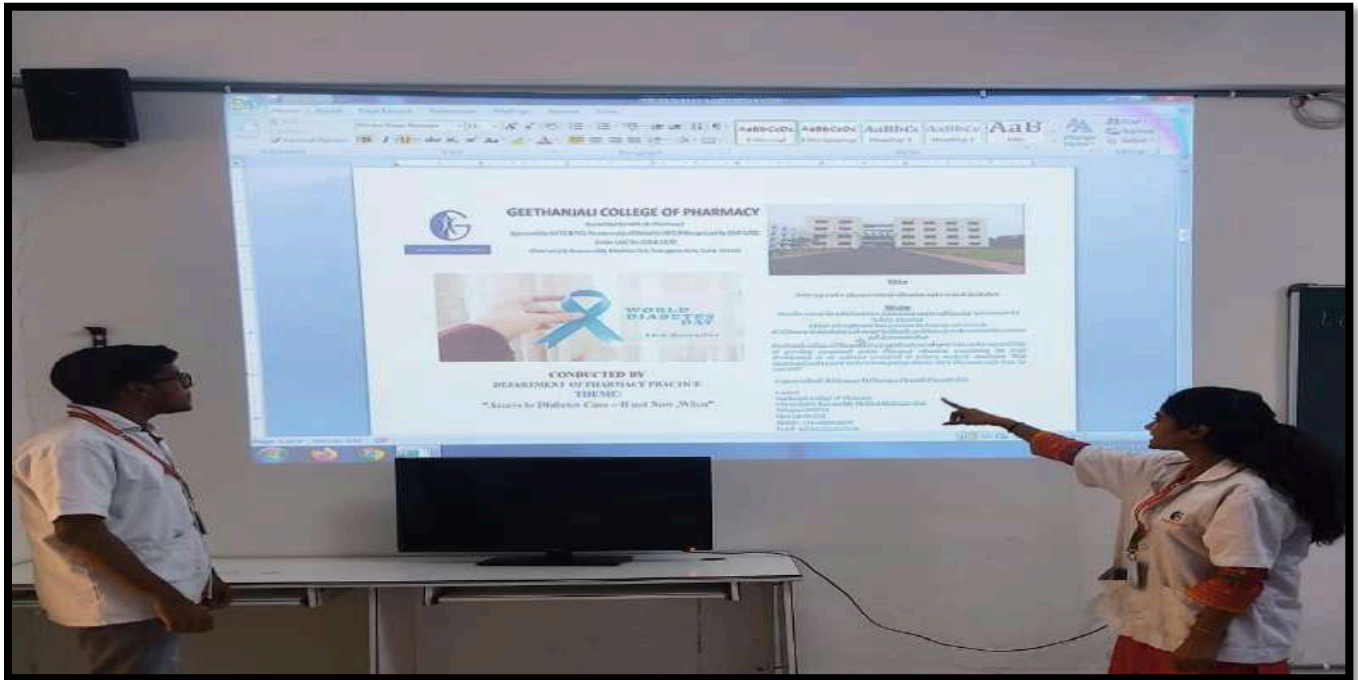
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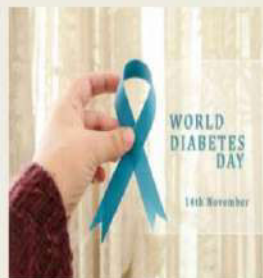

Diabetes is a chronic (lifelong) disease marked by high levels of sugar in the blood.

The Types of Diabetes

There are two Types of diabetes..... •

- One is Type 1 Diabetes
- The other is Type 2 Diabetes

What is Type 1 Diabetes?

Type 1 diabetes is a chronic (lifelong) disease that occurs when the pancreas does not produce enough insulin to properly control blood sugar levels.

What Causes Type 1 Diabetes?

The body's own immune system attacks and destroys beta cells in the pancreas that are responsible for creating the hormone insulin.

What is Type 2 Diabetes?

Type 2 diabetes formerly called non-insulin dependent diabetes is a disorder that is characterized by high blood glucose in the context of insulin resistance and relative insulin deficiency.

What Causes Type 2 Diabetes?

Type 2 diabetes occurs when the pancreas doesn't make enough insulin or the cells of the body become resistant to insulin.

How should you treat low blood sugars? If you sugar is 70 or lower you should treat it with....

- a glass of juice - glass of soft drink

2 or more glucose tablets if necessary








What is Hypoglycemia?

Hypoglycemia, also called low blood glucose or low blood sugar, occurs when blood glucose drops below normal levels.

Symptoms of Hypoglycemia

Causes: Too little food, too much insulin or diabetes medicine, or extra activity.

Onset: Sudden, may progress to insulin shock.

What is Hyperglycemia?

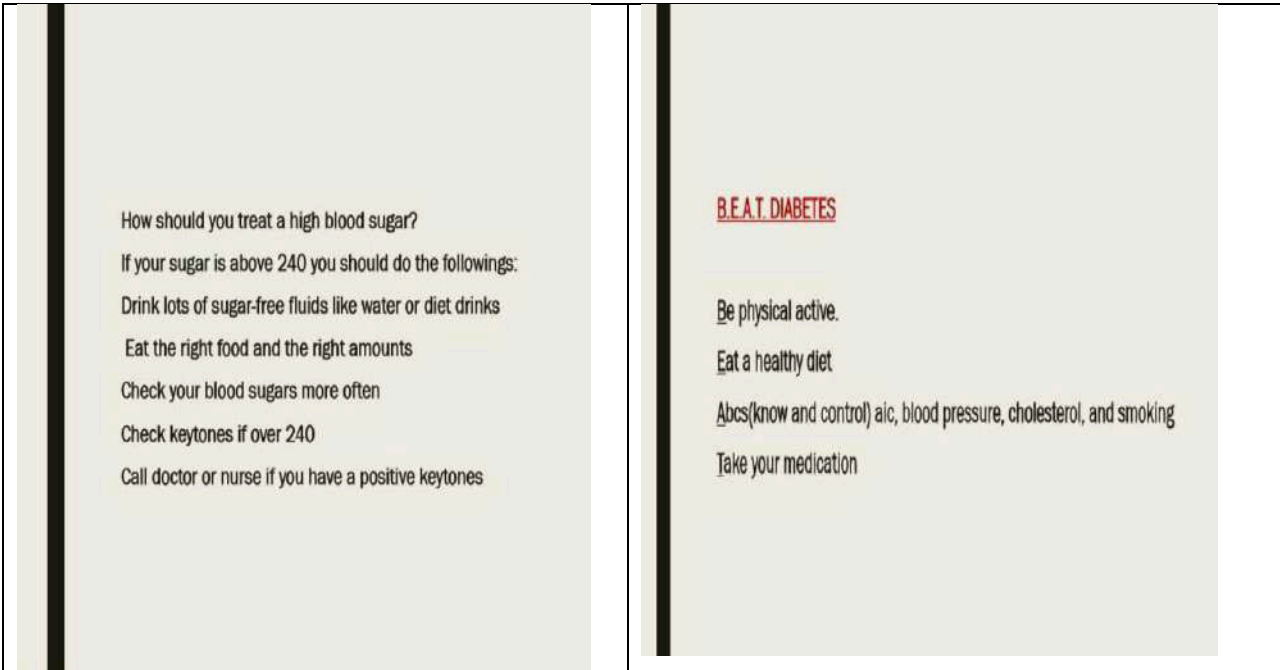
Hyperglycemia, or high blood sugar is a condition in which an excessive amount of glucose circulates in the blood plasma.

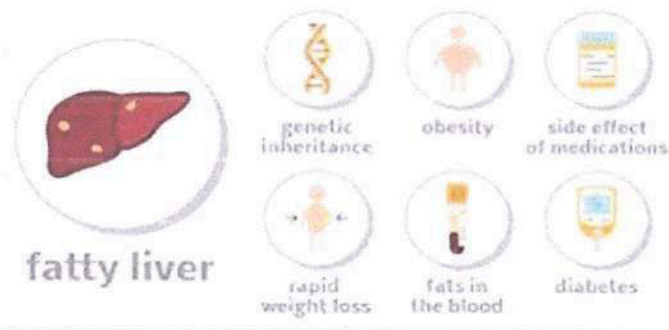

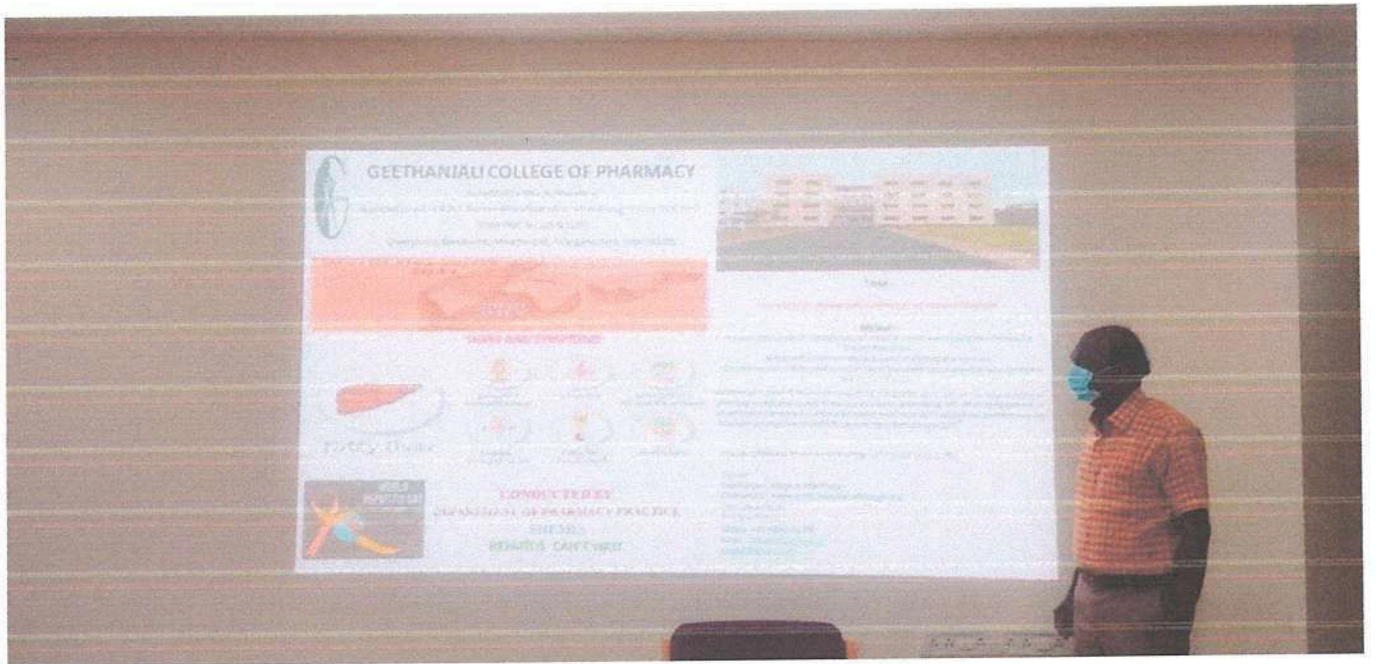



What is hepatitis?

Hepatitis refers to an inflammatory condition of the liver. It's commonly caused by a viral infection, but there are other possible causes of hepatitis. These include autoimmune hepatitis and hepatitis that occurs as a secondary result of medications, drugs, toxins, and alcohol. Autoimmune hepatitis is a disease that occurs when your body makes antibodies against your liver tissue.

Hepatitis is *acute* if it resolves within six months, and *chronic* if it lasts longer than six months. Acute hepatitis can resolve on its own, progress to chronic hepatitis, or (rarely) result in acute liver failure. Chronic hepatitis may progress to scarring of the liver (cirrhosis), liver failure, and liver cancer.

The 5 types of viral hepatitis:

Viral infections of the liver that are classified as hepatitis include hepatitis A, B, C, D, and E. A different virus is responsible for each type of virally transmitted hepatitis.

Hepatitis A is always an acute, short-term disease, while hepatitis B, C, and D are most likely to become ongoing and chronic. Hepatitis E is usually acute but can be particularly dangerous in pregnant women.

Hepatitis A

Hepatitis A is caused by an infection with the hepatitis A virus (HAV). This type of hepatitis is most commonly transmitted by consuming food or water contaminated by feces from a person infected with hepatitis A.

Hepatitis B

Hepatitis B is transmitted through contact with infectious body fluids, such as blood, vaginal secretions, or semen, containing the hepatitis B virus (HBV). Injection drug use, having sex with an infected partner, or sharing razors with an infected person increase your risk of getting hepatitis B.

Hepatitis C

Hepatitis C comes from the hepatitis C virus (HCV). Hepatitis C is transmitted through direct contact with infected body fluids, typically through injection drug use and sexual contact. HCV is among the most common bloodborne viral infections in the United States.

Hepatitis D

Also called delta hepatitis, hepatitis D is a serious liver disease caused by the hepatitis D virus (HDV). HDV is contracted through direct contact with infected blood. Hepatitis D is a rare form of hepatitis that only occurs in conjunction with hepatitis B infection. The hepatitis D virus can't multiply without the presence of hepatitis B.

Hepatitis E

Hepatitis E is a waterborne disease caused by the hepatitis E virus (HEV). Hepatitis E is mainly found in areas with poor sanitation and typically results from ingesting fecal matter that contaminates the water supply.



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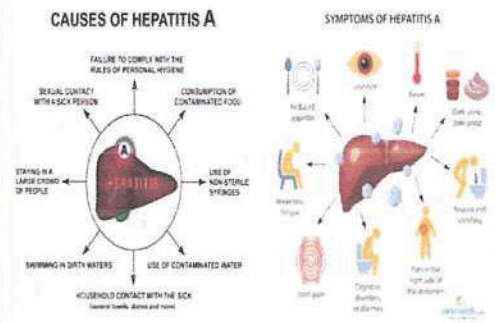
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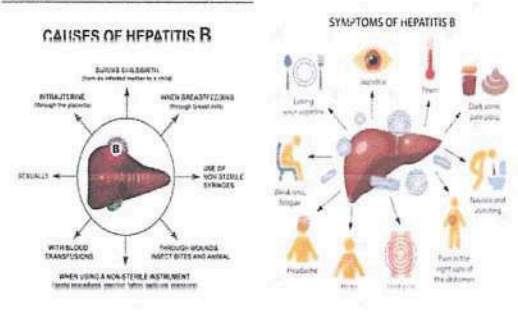
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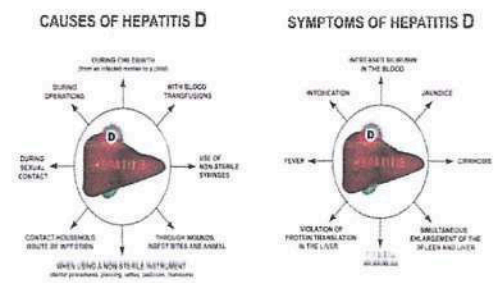

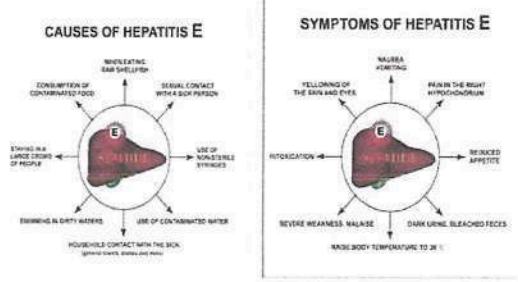

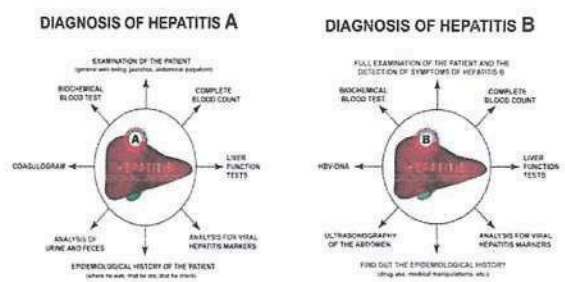

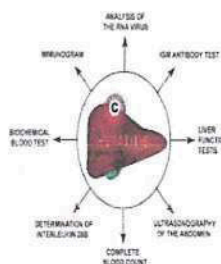
DIAGNOSIS OF HEPATITIS Hepatitis A & B



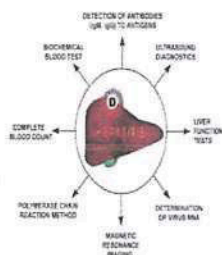

DIAGNOSIS OF HEPATITIS C

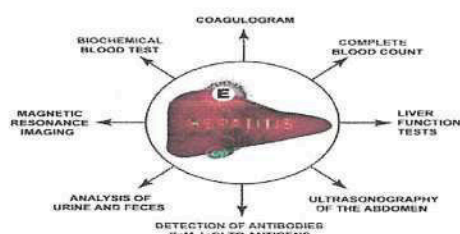


DIAGNOSIS OF HEPATITIS D

TREATMENT OPTIONS:

HEPATITIS A

Complete clinical resolution, including avoidance of complications, normalization of liver function, and reduction of infectivity and transmission. No specific treatment options exist for HAV. Management of HAV infection is primarily supportive. Steroid use is not recommended.

HEPATITIS B

The immune-mediating agents approved as first-line therapy are interferon (IFN)-alfa and pegylated (peg) IFN-alfa. The antiviral agents lamivudine, telbivudine, adefovir, entecavir, and tenofovir are all approved as first-line therapy options for chronic HBV.

HEPATITIS C

Therapeutic Regimen	Duration
1 Peg-IFN + ribavirin + boceprevir or telaprevir	Variable 24–48 weeks
Peg-IFN + nbavirin	24 weeks

DISCUSSION: About World Hepatitis Day and its Importance

World Hepatitis Day aims to promote the prevention and testing of all the five types of the disease: A, B, C, D, and E. This day was established by the World Health Assembly and is celebrated on July 28 so that the World could celebrate the birthday of Baruch Samuel Blumberg, the first scientist to discover hepatitis B.

Hepatitis is a global epidemic. It is possible to get hepatitis anywhere and at any age. In fact, as per the official World Hepatitis Day website, an estimated 400 million people are infected by hepatitis globally. Hepatitis can be contracted through blood contact or through sexual intercourse.

Hepatitis Day is also a means of commemorating the huge strides of scientific developments that have been made when it comes to research and treatment for Hepatitis. The good news is that in the last 100 years, considerable progress has been made when it comes to both preventing hepatitis and treating it. Vaccines now exist for both hepatitis A and B.



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From an early age, those in developing countries can choose to automatically receive these vaccines from their doctors. While hepatitis C is easily treated, getting D and E are rare. What's more, the World Hepatitis Alliance has set a challenge to eliminate all forms of viral hepatitis by year 2030 as these pose as a huge public health threat. When World Hepatitis Day is recognized each year, awareness is spread, and this becomes a much more achievable goal.

Theme of World Hepatitis Day 2021

In 2021, the theme is 'Hepatitis Can't Wait', conveying the urgency of efforts needed to eliminate hepatitis as a public health threat by 2030.

OUTCOMES:

The conducted awareness programme helped to increase the knowledge about the disease and recent developments and research.

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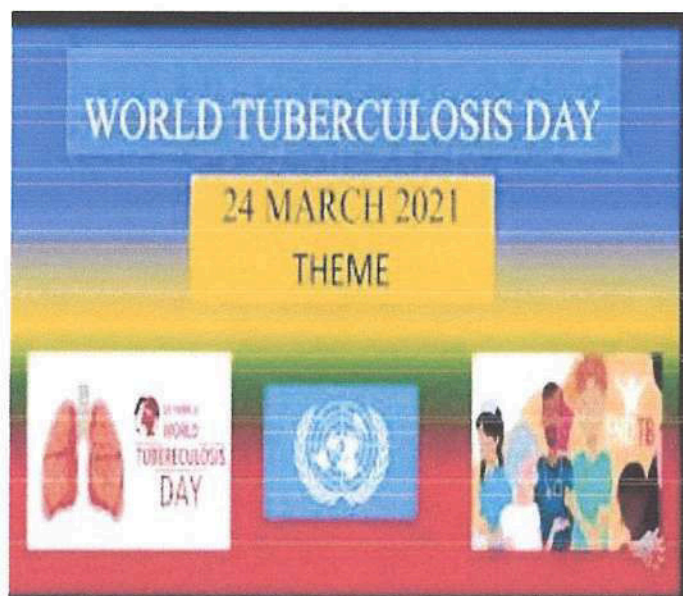

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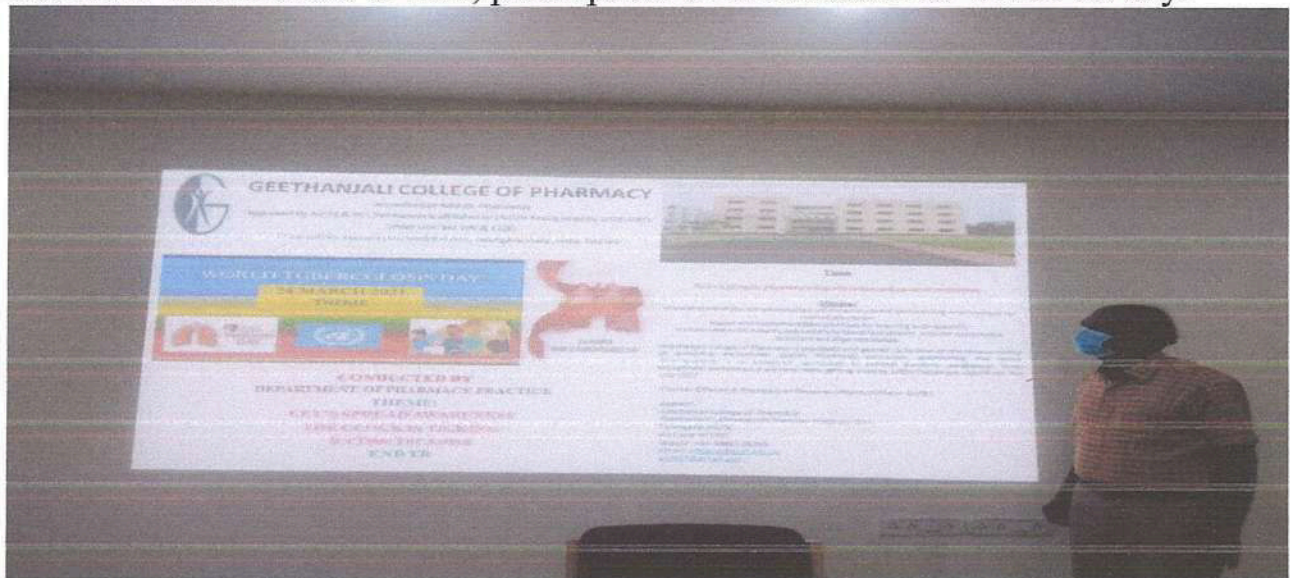

INTRODUCTION:

Geethanjali College of Pharmacy, Cheeryal, Hyderabad was established in the year 2007 and has organized World TUBERCULOSIS day on 024/03/2021 to raise awareness about tuberculosis. This day aims to increase efforts to end the global epidemic of TB, one of the world's deadliest infectious killers which according to data by WHO.

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Tuberculosis

Tuberculosis (TB) is an infectious disease usually caused by *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* (MTB) bacteria. Tuberculosis generally affects the lungs, but can also affect other parts of the body. Most infections show no symptoms, in which case it is known as latent tuberculosis.

Tuberculosis is spread from one person to the next through the air when people who have active TB in their lungs cough, spit, speak, or sneeze. People with latent TB do not spread the disease. As of 2018, one quarter of the world's population was thought to have latent infection with TB. New infections occur in about 1% of the population each year. In 2018, there were more than 10 million cases of active TB, resulting in 1.5 million deaths and making it the number one cause of death from an infectious disease at that time.

Tuberculosis may become a chronic illness and cause extensive scarring in the upper lobes of the lungs. The upper lung lobes are more frequently affected by tuberculosis than the lower ones. The reason for this difference is not clear. It may be due to either better air flow, or poor lymph drainage within the upper lungs.

Extrapulmonary

In 15–20% of active cases, the infection spreads outside the lungs, causing other kinds of TB. These are collectively denoted as "extrapulmonary tuberculosis". Extrapulmonary TB occurs more commonly in people with a weakened immune system and young children. In those with HIV, this occurs in more than 50% of cases. Notable extrapulmonary infection sites include the pleura (in tuberculous pleurisy), the central nervous system (in tuberculous meningitis), the lymphatic system (in scrofula of the neck), the genitourinary system (in urogenital tuberculosis), and the bones and joints (in Pott disease of the spine), among others. A potentially more serious, widespread form of TB is called "disseminated tuberculosis", it is also known as miliary tuberculosis. Miliary TB currently makes up about 10% of extrapulmonary cases.

Signs and symptoms:

Tuberculosis may infect any part of the body, but most commonly occurs in the lungs (known as pulmonary tuberculosis). Extrapulmonary TB occurs when tuberculosis develops outside of the lungs, although extrapulmonary TB may coexist with pulmonary TB.

General signs and symptoms include fever, chills, night sweats, loss of appetite, weight loss, and fatigue. Significant nail clubbing may also occur.

Pulmonary:

If a tuberculosis infection does become active, it most commonly involves the lungs (in about 90% of cases). Symptoms may include chest pain and a prolonged cough producing sputum. About 25% of people may not have any symptoms (i.e. they remain "asymptomatic"). Occasionally, people may cough up blood in small amounts, and in very rare cases, the infection may erode into the pulmonary artery or a Rasmussen's aneurysm, resulting in massive bleeding.

Causes:

The main cause of TB is *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* (MTB), a small, aerobic, nonmotile bacillus. The high lipid content of this pathogen accounts for many of its unique clinical characteristics. It divides every 16 to 20 hours, which is an extremely slow rate compared with other bacteria, which usually divide in less than an hour. The *M. tuberculosis* complex (MTBC) includes four other TB-causing mycobacteria: *M. bovis*, *M. africanum*, *M. canettii*, and *M. microti*. Other known pathogenic mycobacteria include *M. leprae*, *M. avium*, and *M. kansasii*. The latter two species are classified as "nontuberculous mycobacteria" (NTM). NTM cause neither TB nor leprosy, but they do cause lung diseases that resemble TB.

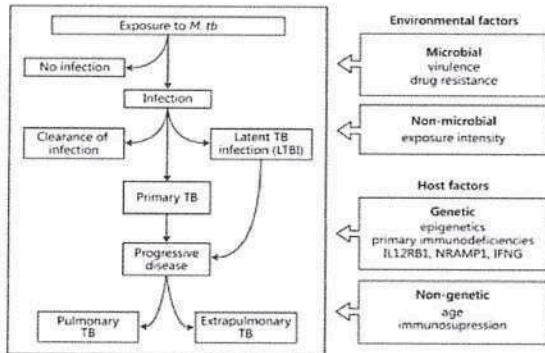
Transmission

When people with active pulmonary TB cough, sneeze, speak, sing, or spit, they expel infectious aerosol droplets 0.5 to 5.0 μm in diameter. A single sneeze can release up to 40,000 droplets. Each one of these droplets may transmit the disease, since the infectious dose of tuberculosis is very small (the inhalation of fewer than 10 bacteria may cause an infection).



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Pathogenesis



Diagnosis:

Active tuberculosis

Diagnosing active tuberculosis based only on signs and symptoms is difficult, as is diagnosing the disease in those who have a weakened immune system. A chest X-ray and multiple sputum cultures for acid-fast bacilli are typically part of the initial evaluation. Interferon- γ release assays and tuberculin skin tests are of little use in most of the developing world. Interferon gamma release assays (IGRA) have similar limitations in those with HIV.

Latent tuberculosis

The Mantoux tuberculin skin test is often used to screen people at high risk for TB.

Tuberculosis management

First line: All first-line anti-tuberculous drug names:

- > ethambutol
- > isoniazid
- > pyrazinamide
- > rifampicin
- > streptomycin

Second line: The second line drugs (WHO groups 2, 3 and 4) are only used to treat disease that is resistant to first line therapy (i.e., for extensively drug-resistant tuberculosis (XDR-TB) or multidrug-resistant tuberculosis (MDR-TB)).

- > aminoglycosides (WHO group 2): e.g., amikacin (AMK), kanamycin (KM);
- > polypeptides (WHO group 2): e.g., capreomycin, viomycin, enviomycin;
- > fluoroquinolones (WHO group 3): e.g., ciprofloxacin (CIP), levofloxacin, moxifloxacin (MXF);
- > thioamides (WHO group 4): e.g., ethionamide, prothionamide
- > cycloserine (WHO group 4)
- > terizidone (WHO group 5)

Standard regimen:

DOTS stands for "Directly Observed Treatment, Short-course" and is a major plank in the World Health Organization (WHO) Global Plan to Stop TB. The DOTS strategy focuses on five main points of action.

- > Sustained political and financial commitment.
- > Diagnosis of TB by quality ensured sputum smear microscopy.
- > Standardized short course anti TB treatment (SCC) given under direct and supportive observation (DOTS).
- > A regular uninterrupted supply of high quality anti TB drugs.
- > Standardized recording and reporting.

DOTS involved treatment with a four drug regimen:

- > isoniazid (INH),
- > Rifampicin (Rif),
- > Prazinamide (PZA) and
- > Ethambutol (EMB) for 6-9 months.



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Multi drug resistant TB

DOTS also did not take any account of drug resistant TB. Where resistance already exists to first line drugs such as isoniazid and rifampin, the DOTS program reverted to a short course of pyrazinamide and ethambutol. These were at doses insufficient to treat active TB, but in doses large enough to boost resistance. Further, if a patient's TB was not cured, DOTS also called for retreatment with rifampin and isoniazid. So in these circumstances the DOTS programme could actually cause a worsening of the MDR TB situation.

DOTS-Plus strategy

The WHO extended the DOTS programme in 1998 to include the treatment of MDR-TB (called "DOTS-Plus"). Implementation of DOTS-Plus requires the capacity to perform drug-susceptibility testing (not routinely available even in developed countries) and the availability of second-line agents, in addition to all the requirements for DOTS. DOTS-Plus is therefore much more resource-expensive than DOTS, and requires much greater commitment from countries wishing to implement it. Duration is extended upto 18-24months.

DISCUSSION:

Tuberculosis (TB) is a contagious infection that is caused by a bacterium called *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*. Usually, TB bacteria attack the lungs, but they can attack any part of the body such as the kidney, spine, and brain. Previously, TB was a leading cause of death but nowadays, most cases are cured with antibiotics. You just have to take medications for at least 6 to 9 months. Therefore, to raise public awareness about the devastating health, social and economic consequences of TB every year World Tuberculosis (TB) Day is observed. Awareness Day events require a significant amount of effort (such as staff time and resources). It is important to be able to describe specifically how the Awareness Day aligns with your organization's mission and what outcomes you can achieve from an event. Each year, we recognize World TB day on march 24th. This annual event commemorates the date in 1882 when Dr. Robert Koch announced his discovery of *Mycobacterium tuberculosis*, the bacillus that causes TB.

Each World TB Day addresses a different theme. The theme of World TB Day 2021 is "The clock is Ticking"- conveys the sense that the covid 19 pandemic has delayed the progress of curing TB and the world is running out of time to act on the commitments to end TB made by global leaders. Each day, nearly 4000 lose their lives to TB and close to 28,000 people fall ill with this preventable and curable disease.

OUTCOMES:

The conducted awareness programme helped to increase the knowledge about the disease and recent developments and research. DOTS therapy was clearly explained to the members.

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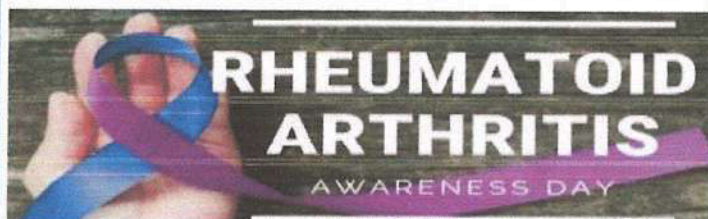
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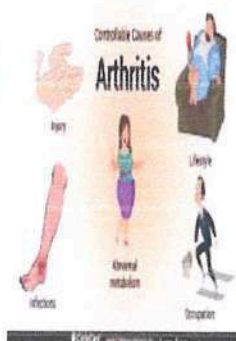

What's Rheumatoid Arthritis?

Rheumatoid arthritis (RA) is an autoimmune disease that can cause joint pain and damage throughout your body.

The joint damage that RA causes usually happens on both sides of the body. So, if a joint is affected in one of your arms or legs, the same joint in the other arm or leg will probably be affected, too. This is one way that doctors distinguish RA from other forms of arthritis, such as osteoarthritis (OA).

Treatments work best when RA is diagnosed early, so it's important to learn the signs. Read on to learn everything you want to know about RA, from types and symptoms to home remedies, diets, and other treatments.

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Types of Rheumatoid Arthritis

The three main types of rheumatoid arthritis (RA) are

- seropositive and
- seronegative RA, with
- juvenile RA being another type that only affects children.

Seropositive RA

A seropositive RA diagnosis refers to positive anti-CCP and/or RF blood tests. Anti-CCP is used to identify antibodies that attack the body's healthy cells, which results in inflammation.

Seropositive RA is considered to be more progressive and severe than seronegative RA. Seropositive RA is associated with more joint damage, deformity, rheumatoid nodules, development of vasculitis, lung issues, and extra-articular manifestations.

Seronegative RA

Like seropositive RA, systemic symptoms are common, such as fever and fatigue. Rheumatoid nodules, vasculitis, and lung issues are less likely in seronegative RA.

Seronegative RA, in which anti-CCP and RA are absent, is less common than the seropositive type. In an early 2000 study, 12 out of every 100,000 RA patients were seronegative, and this number increased to 20 per 100,000 years later.

This type of RA causes the classic RA symptoms, but they are often less severe and can be unpredictable. The diagnosis of seronegative RA is based on signs and symptoms of the condition, including morning stiffness, joint stiffness, swelling, pain, and symmetrical involvement of multiple joints.

Juvenile RA

Juvenile RA, often referred to as juvenile idiopathic arthritis (JIA), is a form of RA that affects children aged 16 and under. While kids often have growing pains, the pain, stiffness, and swelling of JIA are signs of disease and require treatment. Children with JIA may also have fevers, rash, and swollen lymph nodes. The goal of JIA treatment is to control inflammation and pain to help keep the child active and social. Treatments for JIA include medications and therapy. In some situations, surgery may be warranted.

Rheumatoid arthritis causes:

Factors that may trigger onset of RA involve:

- exposure to certain types of bacteria, such as those associated with periodontal disease
- having a history of viral infections, such as the Epstein-Barr virus, which causes mononucleosis
- trauma or injury, such as bone breakage or fracture, dislocation of a joint, and ligament damage
- smoking cigarettes
- having obesity

Rheumatoid arthritis in the hands:

Arthritis in the hands may start as a low-level burning sensation that you feel at the end of the day. Eventually, you may experience pain that isn't necessarily from using your hands. This pain can get quite severe if you don't treat it.

Symptoms:

RA is a chronic disease marked by symptoms of inflammation and pain in the joints. These symptoms and signs occur during periods known as flares or exacerbations. Other times are known as periods of remission — this is when symptoms disappear completely.

While RA symptoms can affect several organs in the body, the joint symptoms of RA include:

- joint pain
- joint swelling
- joint stiffness & loss of joint function and deformities

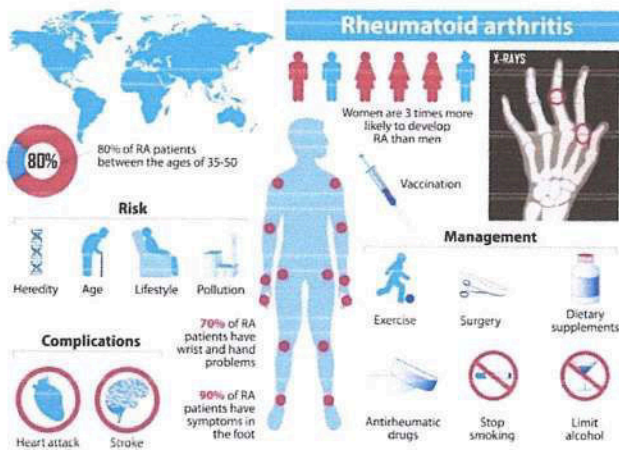
Symptoms can vary from mild to severe. It's important not to ignore your symptoms, even if they come and go. Knowing the early signs of RA will help you and your healthcare provider better treat and manage it.

Diagnosis:

Diagnosing RA can take time and may require multiple lab tests to confirm clinical examination findings. Your healthcare provider will use several tools to diagnose RA.

First, they'll ask about your symptoms and medical history. They'll also perform a physical exam of your joints. This will include:

- looking for swelling and redness
- examining joint function and range of motion
- touching the affected joints to check for warmth and tenderness
- testing your reflexes and muscle strength

If they suspect RA, they'll most likely refer you to a specialist called a rheumatologist.

Since no single test can confirm a diagnosis of RA, your healthcare provider or rheumatologist may use several different types of tests.

They may test your blood for certain substances like antibodies, or check the level of certain substances like acute phase reactants. Trusted Source that are elevated during inflammatory conditions. These can be a sign of RA and help support the diagnosis. They may also request certain imaging tests, such as an ultrasound, X-ray, or MRI.

Blood tests for Rheumatoid Arthritis:

➤**Rheumatoid factor test.** The RF blood test checks for a protein called rheumatoid factor. High levels of rheumatoid factor are associated with autoimmune diseases, especially RA.

➤**Anticitrullinated protein antibody test (anti-CCP).** This test looks for an antibody that's associated with RA. People who have this antibody usually have the disease. However, not everyone with RA tests positive for this antibody. The anti-CCP Ab is more specific for RA than the RF test

➤**Antinuclear antibody test.** The antinuclear antibody panel tests your immune system to see if it's producing antibodies. Your body may make antibodies as a response to many different types of conditions, including RA.

➤**Erythrocyte sedimentation rate.** The ESR test helps determine the degree of inflammation in your body. The result tells your doctor whether inflammation is present. However, it doesn't indicate the cause of the inflammation.

➤**C-reactive protein test.** A severe infection or significant inflammation anywhere in your body can trigger your liver to make C-reactive protein. High levels of this inflammatory marker are associated with RA.

Treatment:

Treatments may include:

1. medications
2. Alternative or home remedies
3. dietary changes
4. specific types of exercise

1. Rheumatoid arthritis Medications:

There are many types of medication for RA. Some of these medications help to reduce the pain and inflammation of RA. Some help to reduce flares and limit the damage that RA does to your joints. The following over-the-counter medications help reduce the pain and inflammation during RA flares:

- ❖Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs (NSAIDs)
- corticosteroids
- acetaminophen

The following drugs work to slow the damage that RA can cause to your body:



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These new generation biologic DMARDs provide a targeted response to inflammation rather than blocking your body's entire immune system response. They may be an effective treatment for people who don't respond to more traditional DMARDs. Disease-modifying antirheumatic drugs (DMARDs). DMARDs work by blocking your body's immune system response. This helps to slow down the progression of RA.

❖ Janus kinase (JAK) inhibitors. These are a new subcategory OF DMARDs that block certain immune responses. These are drugs that your healthcare provider may use to help prevent inflammation and stop damage to your joints when DMARDs and biologic DMARDs don't work for you.

2. Home remedies for rheumatoid arthritis:

Certain home remedies and lifestyle adjustments may help to improve your quality of life when living with RA. This includes exercise, rest, and assistive devices.

3. Rheumatoid arthritis diet:

Foods high in omega-3 fatty acids include:

- fatty fish like salmon, tuna, herring, and mackerel
- chia seeds
- flax seeds
- walnuts

Antioxidants, such as vitamins A, C, and E, and selenium, may also help reduce inflammation. Foods high in antioxidants include:

- berries, such as blueberries, cranberries, goji berries, and strawberries
- dark chocolate
- spinach
- kidney beans

Eating lots of fiber is also important. According to some researchers, fiber may help reduce inflammatory responses which may decrease C-reactive protein levels. Choose whole grain foods, fresh vegetables, and fresh fruit. Strawberries may be particularly beneficial.

Foods containing flavonoids can also help to counter inflammation in the body.

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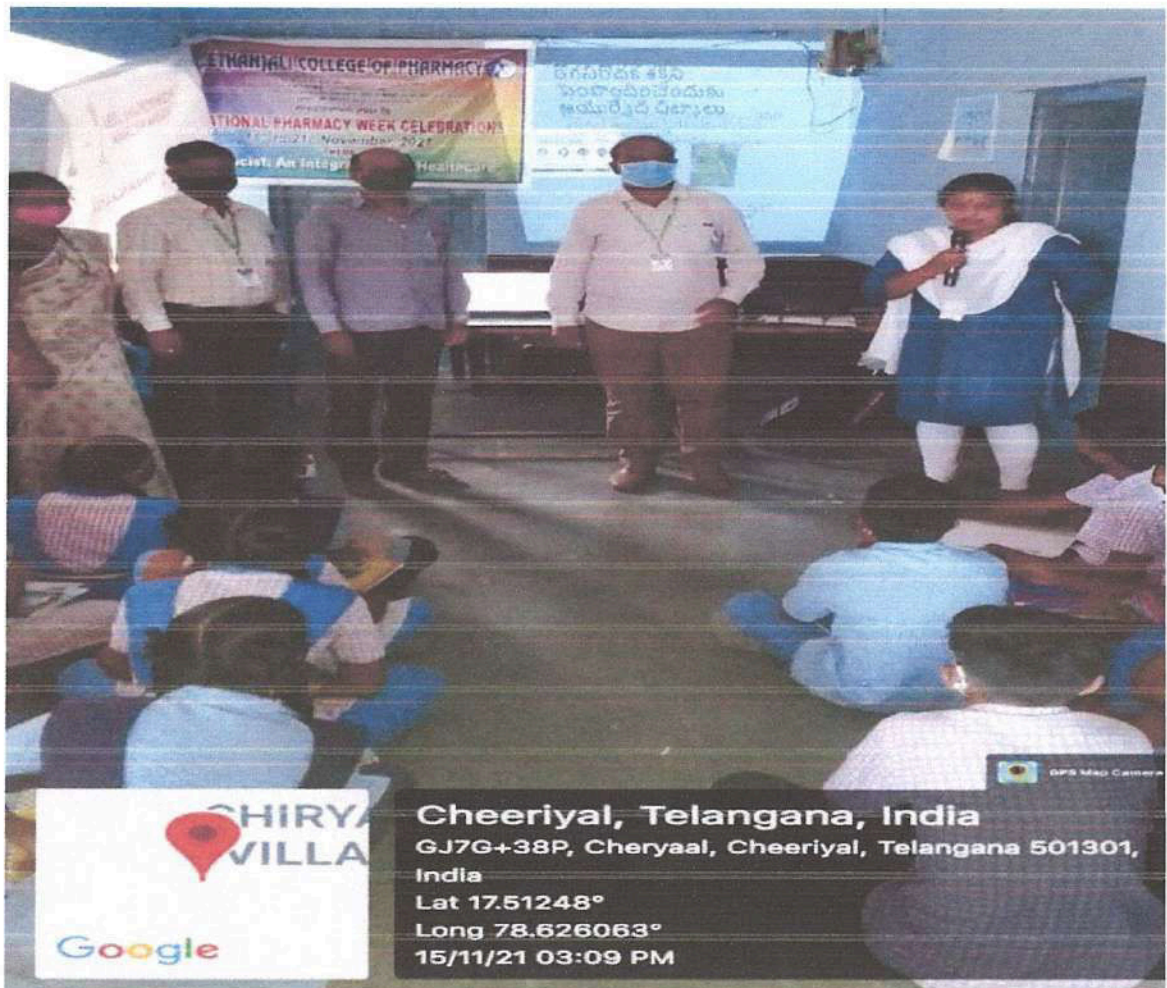

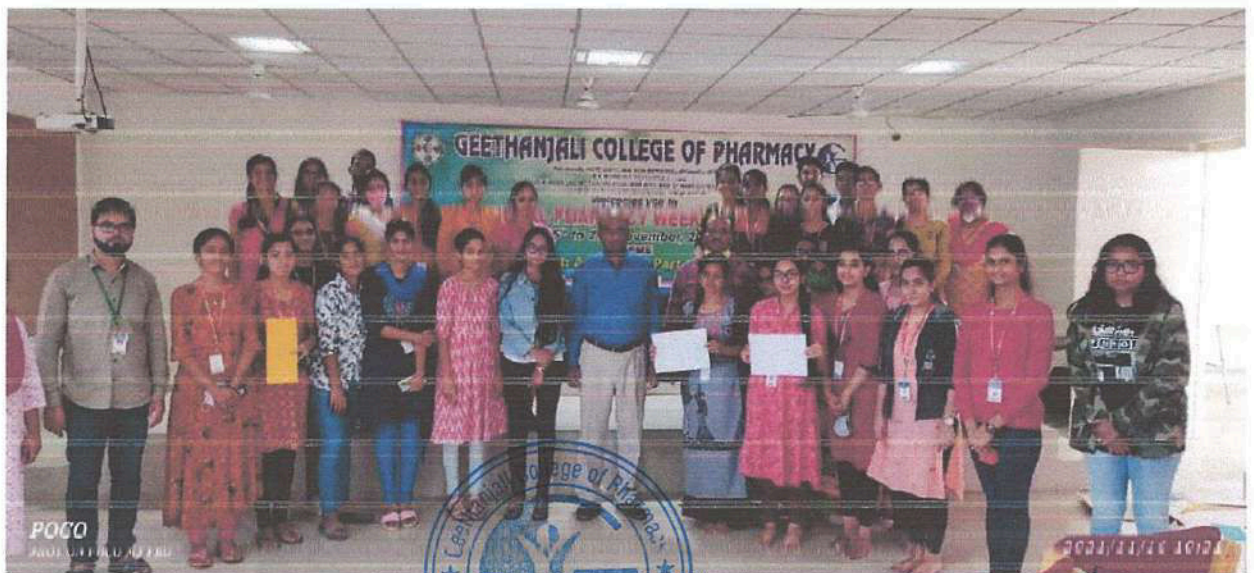

What is AIDS?
AIDS is a fatal and untreatable disease in which the patient's immunity decreases gradually, and finally the immune system is destroyed. This causes the patient to fall prey to several diseases.

Causes:

- AIDS is caused by a virus called Human Immunodeficiency Virus (HIV).
- This virus is found mainly in the blood, semen, and vaginal secretions of a patient.

How AIDS Spread:
AIDS is spread only through the following Methodological Reasons:

- Sexual intercourse:** Having sexual intercourse without any protection with an HIV/AIDS patient. This includes sexual relations between a man/woman or two men in the presence of any other sexual disease, the chances of being infected with AIDS are much greater.
- Blood Transfusion or using contaminated syringes:** Transfusion of infected blood, or using contaminated syringes can cause the spread of AIDS.
- Mother to child:** An unborn child can contract AIDS from its mother during pregnancy, after delivery or by breastfeeding.

AIDS not spread:

- AIDS is not spread by living, working, studying, playing, shaking hands, sharing a common bathroom, toilet, tub or pool with the patient.
- NO, AIDS is a disease infecting humans. It is not spread by Mosquitoes or bedbugs.

HIV STRUCTURE:

SYMPTOMS:
An HIV positive patient can live a healthy life for two years or more. Then gradually, symptoms of the disease begin to appear. The symptoms include:

- Reduction of 10% of body weight to 3 months.
- Persistent diarrhoea for more than one month.
- Persistent fever for more than one month.
- A persistent cough.

Who is more susceptible?
HIV/AIDS has become a disease of inequality and opportunity. In addition to sexually active individuals, intravenous drug users and children with HIV positive mothers, marginalized populations are most at risk. Other groups include:

- Persons in developing countries more than in developed countries.
- Women more than men.
- Youth more vulnerable than other populations.

HIV is the world's leading infectious killer. 82% of AIDS cases are from unwanted sexual contact.
