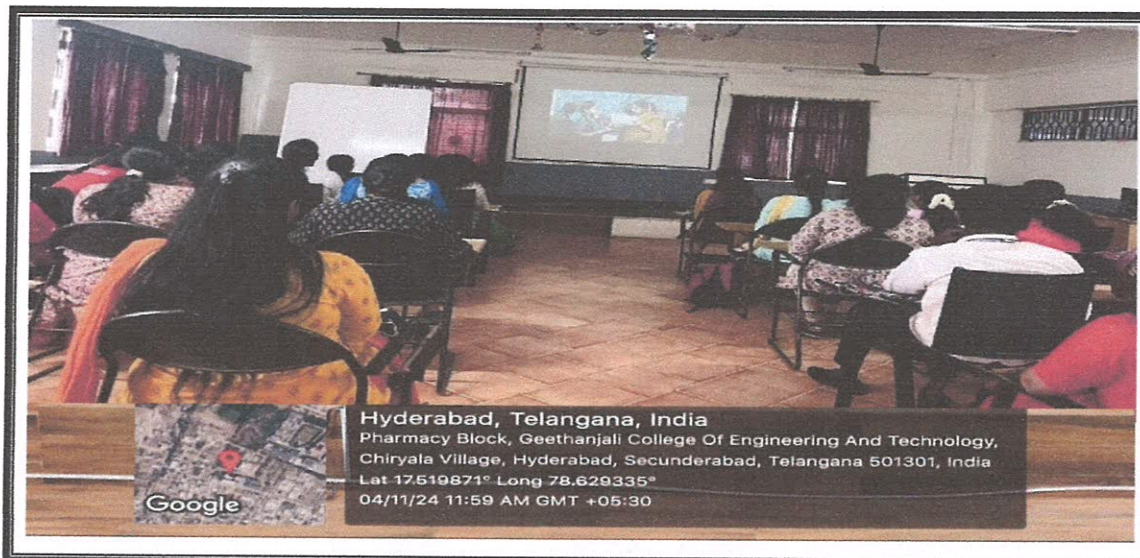


FILM SCREENING:

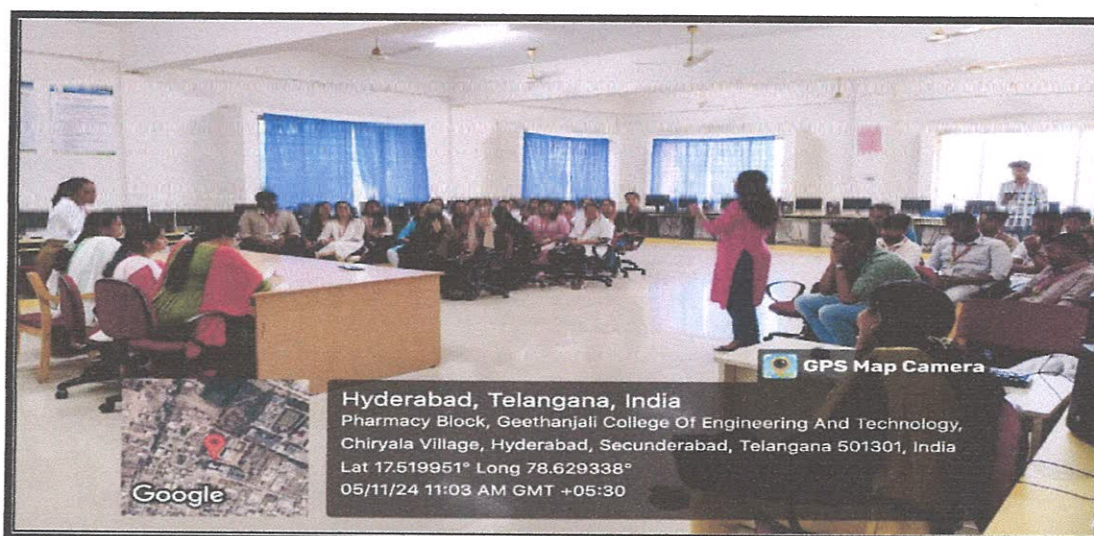

REPORT ON: A Talk on Personality Development and Gender Sensitization A.Y. 2023-24 Reg.

Developing a student's personality is essential to giving them the communication skills they need to succeed academically. In contrast, gender equality is a broad idea that includes political, social, and economic equality between the sexes. A presentation on "Personality Development and Gender Sensitization" was arranged by the Gender Sensitization Cell (GSC) & Women Protection Cell (WPC) on March 8th, 2024. The event was opened by Dr. M. Ravi Kumar, the principal of Geethanjali College of Pharmacy, who stressed that students' behaviour is significantly impacted by the amount of encouragement they receive along their educational path.

The speaker Dr. Tenali Rajini Bhushan emphasized how a student's attitude, behaviour, and relationships with others are greatly influenced by how driven or unmotivated their superiors have been. In addition, the speaker advocated for gender equality and stressed the significance of establishing a psychological, social, and physical environment that increases awareness and discourages sexual harassment of women. In all, 145 students participated in the event and shared their opinions on the idea.



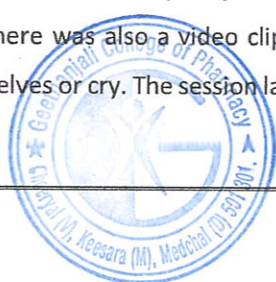

She concluded her talk by advising the students through a diverse range of discussions, she inspired students to become agents of change and champion of women's rights in their communities and beyond.

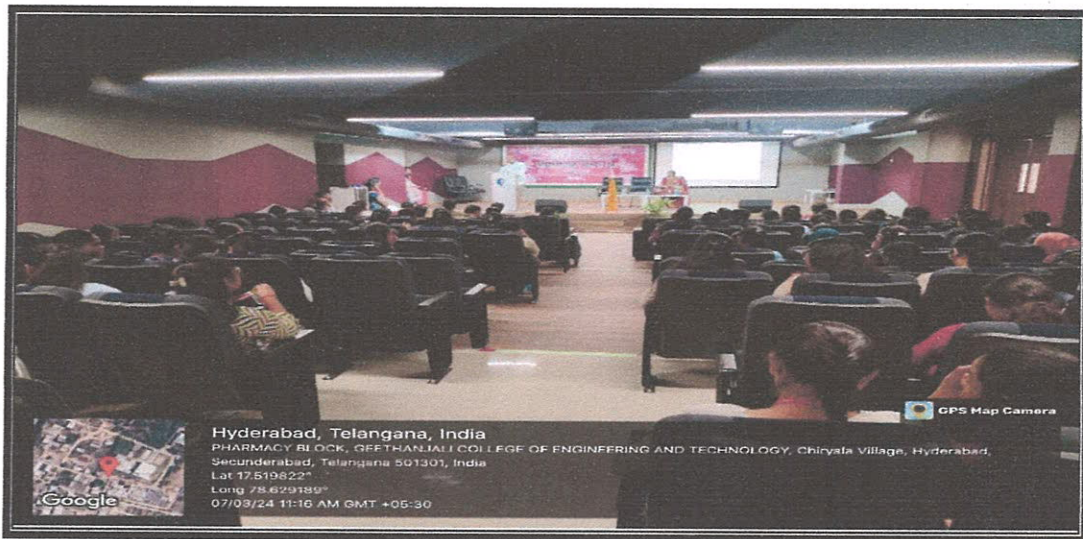

the need for change in attitude by respecting women and creating awareness and teaching boys about gender equality from childhood. The program ended with vote of thanks and refreshments.



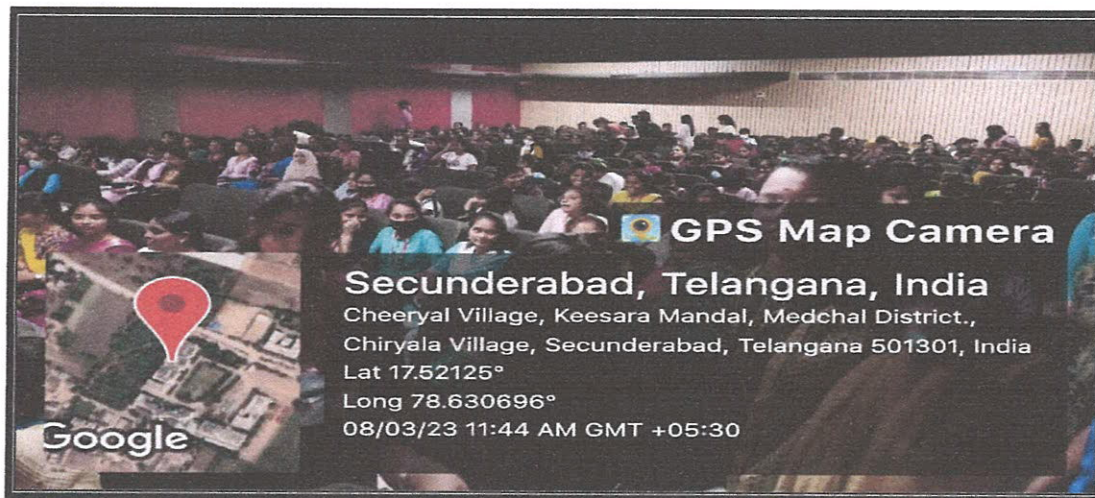
Firstly, she gave a brief life cycle approach regarding crimes against women starting from female feticide to elder abuse. Dr. Tenali Rajini Bhushan discussed in an elaborate manner about cyber space and its unique characteristics because of which we fall victim to it many at times because of its anonymous nature and thus prevention is better than cure. She provided a number of measures on how to be safe in the cyber space and warned that the digital space is never a 100 percent fool proof system. Due to the unique characteristics of the cyber space and its mode of operation a number of criminal activities easily take place in the digital world. Besides, she mentioned how especially women and girls are abused and violated through social media and encouraged the participants to report any cybercrime. Dr. Tenali Rajini Bhushan provided three mantras to be alert in the cyber space such as, a) Prevention is better than cure; b) Do not believe/ trust the digital identity of any person; c) Never use/download anything from the cyber space because it is free.

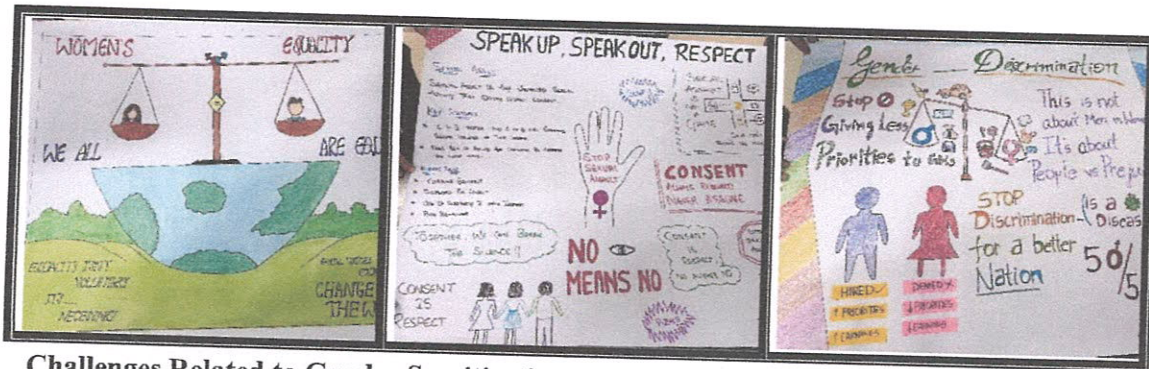


Gender sensitization means teaching people about the different genders. How everyone should be treated and with respect, no matter what their gender is. It's important for a few reasons:

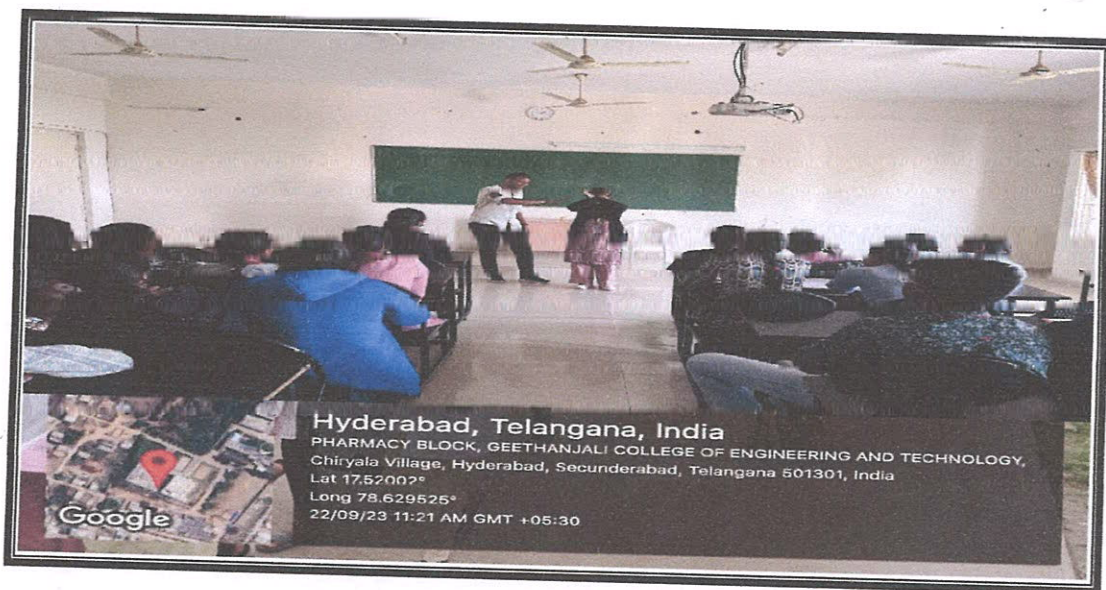

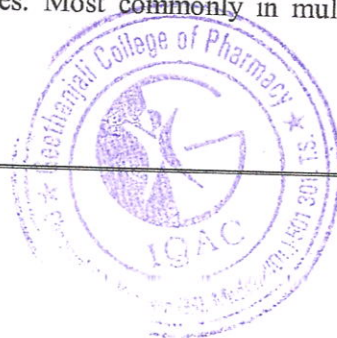
Challenges Related to Gender Sensitization

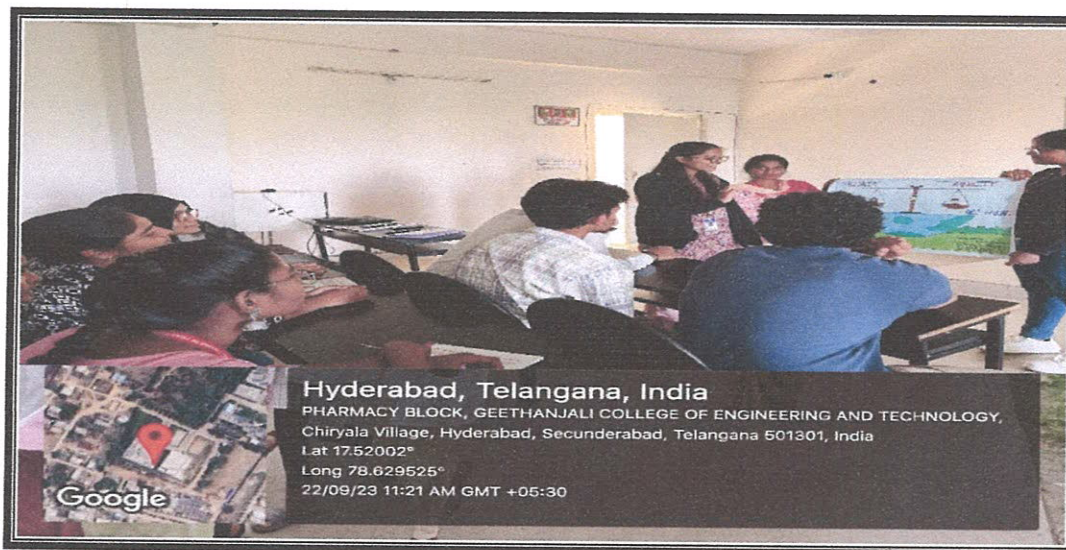

- Language and Communication Barriers make it difficult to involve different communities in gender sensitization initiatives. Most commonly in multilingual and multicultural



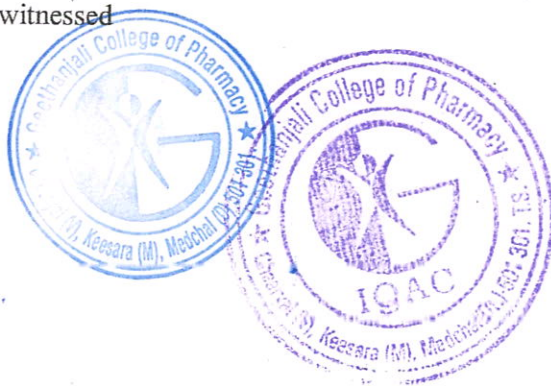
